


Figure 1: The Corresponding Relationship of Front and Back Sides Between the Outline of the Moon and that of Human Head

It is well known that the face of the moon is flatter as that of human body's face, while the back of the moon is more convex as that of human body's head. It is shown by Figure 1 as follows,




Figure 3: The Human Fetus in the Womb Implied by the Outline of the Lunar Mare of the Full Moon




Figure 4: The Pregnancy of the Human Fetus in the Womb and the Variation of the Abdomen of his or her Mother Implied by the Phase of the Moon

after the full moon and the variation of the abdomen of his or her mother. It is shown by Figure 4 as follows,




Figure 5: The Evolution of the Pacific Ocean Implied by the Phase of the Moon in the Time Scale of Tens of Millions of Years




Figure 6: The Expanding and Shrinking of the (Ancient) Atlantic Ocean and the Pacific Ocean Implied by the Shadow and Bright Part of the Phase of the Moon in the Time Scale of Tens of Millions of Years




Figure 7: The Complementary Competing Relationship Between the (Ancient) Atlantic Ocean (Including the Arctic Ocean and the Indian Ocean) and the Pacific Ocean Implied by the Phase of the Moon in the Time Scale of Tens of Millions of Years




Figure 8: The Human Individual' Life Implied by the Phase of the Moon
